



# Great News About P-EBT!

Students who received a Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) card for the previous school year, will receive a new P-EBT card with benefits for August and September.

## **Who will be getting P-EBT benefits for August and September?**

Only students who received P-EBT in the last school year (between March and June) will receive benefits for August and September. **Students who are newly eligible to free or reduced price meals for this school year are not eligible to P-EBT benefits at this time.**

## **How will families receive P-EBT for August and September?**

Families will receive a new P-EBT card in the mail between late October and late December. Each eligible child in the home will receive one P-EBT card. Benefits will **not** be deposited to the old P-EBT card.

## **What if a family has moved?**

Families who have moved since the last school year should contact the P-EBT helpline (877) 328-9677 to report address changes, and a new P-EBT card will be mailed to the new address.

## **How much will families receive?**

Families will receive \$5.86 per day, up to a maximum of \$246 for both August and September, for each eligible child. The exact amount will depend on when the child's school started and the number of virtual learning days that have taken place.

## **Can families still enroll for benefits?**

No. Families who did not receive P-EBT in the 2019-2020 school year will not be eligible to the P-EBT extension. There is no new enrollment for P-EBT at this time.
