




Changing Demographics United States, 1980-2060




Changing Demographics California, 1980-2060



Changing Demographics Los Angeles County, 1980-2060




Immigrant Share of Population Over Time, 1980-2022






Change in Youth Population (<18), 2000-2010, 2010-2022, California, by Race/Ethnicity




Race/Ethnicity by Nativity, Los Angeles County, 2017-2021



Mixed-status Families in Los Angeles County, 2021




Recency of Arrival by Status, Los Angeles County, 2021



First 5 Population Share by Nativity/Status of Parents, Los Angeles County, 2017-2021







Percent of pop, age 0-5, by County 2010









Percent of pop, age 0-5, by County 2030






RACIAL INEQUALITY TODAY

Median Household Income (in 2021 \$) by Race/Ethnicity, Los Angeles County, 2017-2021




RACIAL INEQUALITY TOMORROW

Median Household Income (in 2021 \$) with Children Under 5 by Race/Ethnicity, Los Angeles County, 2017-2021






