Funding from the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and California Department of Education (CDE) increases access to quality child care for eligible low-income families. Children receive care in a safe and healthy environment, engage in nurturing interactions with child care providers and participate in developmentally appropriate activities.

Referrals to child care for 24.000 families


Employment and Financial Stability
