CCRC's Resources and Response to Los Angeles Wildfires



In response to the wildfires impacting thousands of L.A. County families, CCRC is providing critical resources and information. Legislative Updates

Governor Newsom released his proposal for the 2025-26 state budget on Friday, January 10, 2025. The Governor's budget proposes a \$322.2 Billion balanced budget that focuses on education, economic growth, public safety, and accountability.

The proposed budget maintains:

- Funding level agreements for state-subsidized child care programs.
- Initiatives to fully implement Universal Transitional Kindergarten, Expanded Learning Opportunities Program, and universal school meals.
- A Diaper initiative to improve maternal and newborn health outcomes, as well as a family well-being pilot to measure CalWORKs program outcomes.
